Opioid Epidemic

Just the facts:

Prescription drugs can be just as dangerous as street drugs when taken without a prescription or without doctor supervision.

- ⇒ Opioids are a class of drugs that include prescription pain relievers such as OxyCodone, Hydrocodone, codeine and morphine.
- ⇒ Central Nervous System Depressants can also be abused. These prescription drugs are used to treat anxiety, tension or sleep disorders and include Valium and Xanax.
- ⇒ Stimulants such as Ritalin and Adderall are used to increase brain activity and to treat ADD and ADHD.
- ⇒ Opioid overdoses increased 30 % from July 2016 to September 2017 in 45 states. However, the Midwest region saw opioid overdoses increase 70 % from July 2016 to September 2017.
- ⇒ In 2015, over 20,000 deaths were related to prescription pain relievers.
- ⇒ Most teens report they get prescription medicines from friends and family medicine cabinets or cupboards.
